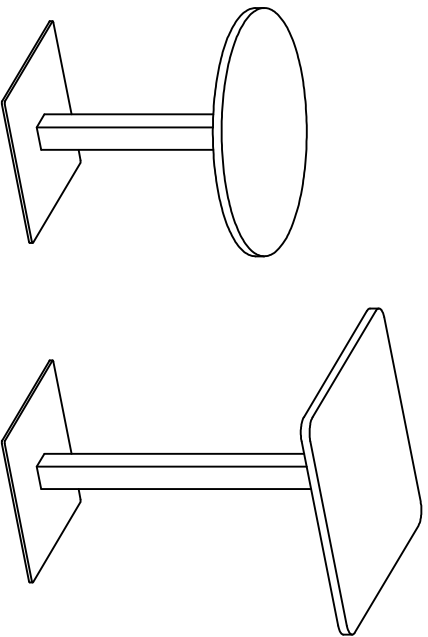

Assembly:

1. Assemble Mounting Plate (B) to Column (C) using Washer (G) Lockwasher (F) & Screw (E) 3 places as shown in Fig. 1.

2. See Important Tip below as shown in Fig. 2.

3. Assemble Base (D) to Column Assembly using Screw (H) 3 places as shown in Fig. 3.

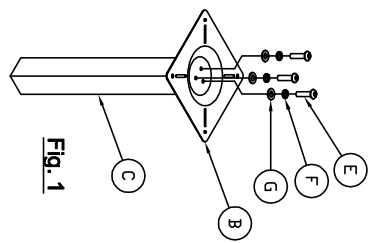

Important Tip:
Mounting Plate & Base Plate to be parallel with the edge of the top (square top only).

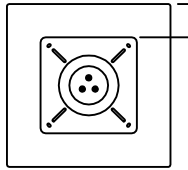

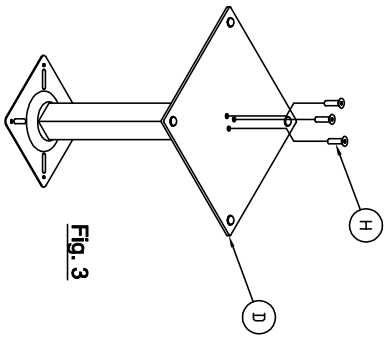

Assembly for Square and Round Tops

4. Place Top (A) face down on a clean flat surface. Center Base Assembly on Top and attach Base using Screws (J), 4 places as shown in Fig. 4.

Tip: Legs to be parallel with the edge of the top (square top only).

Note:

No pilot holes are necessary. Tops are used across multiple bases having different mounting patterns.

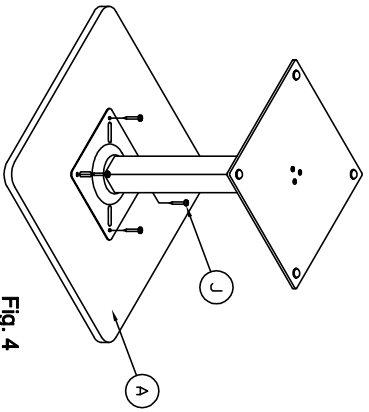

Assembly for Rectangular Tops
1. Place Top (A) face down on a clean flat surface. Center Base Assemblies on Top. Dimension "A" to be equal and is determined by centering the base on the width of the top. Dimension "A" to be equal on 3 sides. Attach Base using Screw (J), 4 places per base as shown in Fig. 5.

Important Tip:
Legs to be parallel with the edge of the top (Square & Rectangular top only).

Note:
No pilot holes are necessary. Tops are used across multiple bases having different mounting patterns.

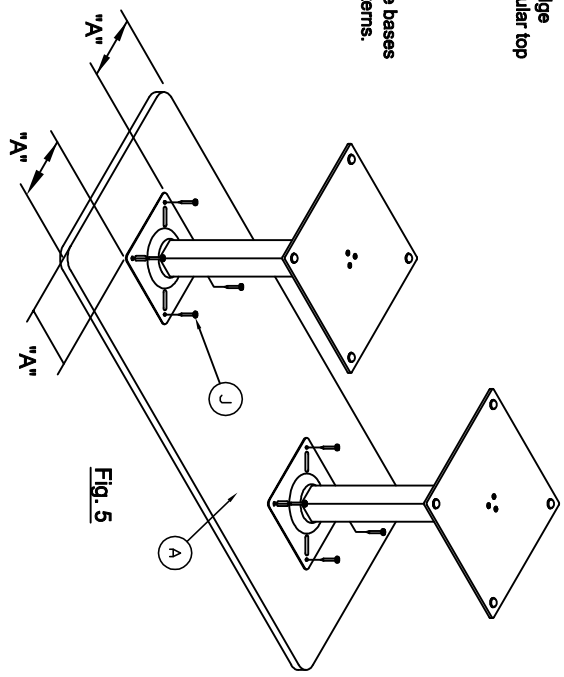
